Captains will advise players who are selected for each match, but will not notify players who have not been selected. Please be assured that all players are always under consideration.

As a reminder, your Committee, since the inauguration of the leagues, has taken the view that in the main, players should play in their own age groups, unless beneficial to the County for players to play elsewhere. This enables us to field the best teams available for all age groups.

#### MASTERS COUNTY CHAMPIONSHIPS

We have again entered teams in the Masters County Championships in the over 40/45/50/55/60/65s age groups.

We are always in need of new players for all age groups. Your help is necessary to identify these players and to notify myself or Jenny Abbott.

This season the 40s will be playing in the Midlands West, 45s and 65s playing in the Midlands, 50s in Midlands East, 55s and 60s will be playing in the North.

Practice fees will be £5 per head. Match fees £8 per person and travelling expenses for away matches at 17p per mile for two nominated cars. This match fee is to cover the cost of refreshments at home matches and travelling costs for two nominated cars from Chilwell Olympia to playing venue and return. All other costs are paid by Notts. B.A. and would be considerably more if we had to use a hall other than our own. Also, any matches cancelled by us could cost in the region of £100 per match, if fixtures are not fulfilled.

Please note that we do not pay travelling expenses or collect match fees for the league play offs and league finals.

#### **COMPETE MEMBERSHIP**

Regulations state that every player will be required to hold a Compete Membership to be eligible to represent his or her County within the Master's Championship. They will then be in line with all Master "Compete" members playing in Tournaments and all Senior Tournament entrants.

To assist counties every match can be played using one "wild card" to cover last minute non-compete players up to 31st December each year, AND from January 1st, may have up to two "wild cards" for any match. The Challenge weekend will count as one "wild card". A player may only have two wild cards in a season, which may be two Championship matches or one Championship match and the Challenge weekend.

If a wildcard player is used for a third time, then they must pay the £15 and become a Compete member well before their third match. If that player plays again without a compete licence their games will be voided

#### Guidance on taking out, renewing or upgrading your Compete memberships.

Click on Membership > Select/click Compete Membership
Select renew or add
Complete the questions
Click Finish.

Your club's subscription should cover the cost of your annual BE registration fee of £15. If you are yet to be registered to a club, this fee will show as £30. You can either wait for your club to register before renewing your compete fee, or request that your club refunds you the £15, however please ensure you are covered ahead of your first fixture.

The fee can be paid any time before the end of the expiry date of your current membership, which can be ascertained by logging into your profile. The new membership will only start after the expiry of your current membership and will last 12 months from there.

Alternatively, you can also pay over the phone by calling Badminton England on 01908 268400 Option 2, quoting your BE number.

All teams/players will need to help with the refreshment procedure. An electronic copy of 'County refreshments – Procedure on match days' will be circulated to Captains and a hard copy will be stored in the snack bar cupboard.
